The Director will be responsible for developing and implementing a comprehensive vision and strategic plan for the athletic bands. They will coordinate and manage all aspects of the program, including scheduling rehearsal space, the maintenance of equipment and uniforms, managing the budget, coordinating travel, and organizing performances. They will collaborate closely with the Director of Spirit to devise effective recruitment strategies and with the Associate Athletic Director to organize team fundraising opportunities, which involve securing sponsorships and donations.

The ideal candidate will hold a Bachelor's degree in music and/or education. Additionally, they will have a minimum of three (3) years of proven experience in leading and managing all aspects of a marching band program, along with a strong understanding and appreciation of the role of athletic bands within a private liberal arts college. Candidates with a Master's degree in music or education, and/or collegiate or secondary-level teaching experience, are highly desirable.

Candidates must be authorized to work in the United States as of the expected hire date and throughout the date of their employment without sponsorship from The College of Idaho. A current valid driver's license is also required and candidates must be vehicle insurable.
