## LOG INTO C OF I PORTAL

Students are emailed login credentials for their C of I Portal once they submit their application.

Students can view their missing items checklist, application status, and financial aid awards in the Application Portal.

## SUBMIT SUPPLEMENTAL MATERIALS

An application is not complete until all required items have been submitted and received by the Office of Admission.



### OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

Counselors can submit transcripts digitally, via post or fax, or email them to [admission@collegeofidaho.edu](mailto:admission@collegeofidaho.edu).



### STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES (OPTIONAL)

Test scores are not required, but students are encouraged to submit scores if they will strengthen their application for admission. Scores may be sent from the counselor, from the testing agency, or applicants may download their Student Score Report with their full name and date of birth included.



### A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION (OPTIONAL)

This can come from a teacher or counselor. Letters may be submitted through the Common Application, emailed to [admission@collegeofidaho.edu](mailto:admission@collegeofidaho.edu), or students may upload them to their Application Portal.

### FACTORS CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION

In addition to the high school transcript and optional test scores and letter of recommendation, the College considers a student's strength of curriculum in making admission decisions. We encourage students to take Honors, Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and Dual-Credit courses whenever possible in order to demonstrate their readiness for the rigor of college-level work. The College also recognizes that not all students have the same access to these types of courses, and will take that into consideration during the application review process.
