THE COLLEGE OF IDAHO HISTORY



The College of Idaho is the state's oldest private college, with a 133-year-old legacy of exceptional academics built around a small, close-knit family that empowers graduates to thrive wherever they go, whatever they do. The College marked its beginning six years before Idaho's statehood when the Presbyterian Church's Wood River Presbytery, meeting in Shoshone, formed a commission to examine the possibility of establishing a Presbyterian college somewhere in the Idaho Territory. The commission found support for such a venture and, in 1890, the Presbytery accepted an offer from a group of Caldwell citizens, led by William Judson Boone, to locate the institution in that community, to be known as The College of Idaho.

Nineteen students showed up for classes during the first school year in 1891. The first classes were held downtown in the Caldwell Presbyterian Church, and a year later the College moved into its own downtown building. The campus moved to its present site on the east side of town in 1910 when Henry and Carrie Blatchley donated 20 acres of land. Sterry Hall, a classroom and administration building, and Finney Hall, the first residence hall, were built

that year. Voorhees Hall, the second of what would become a total of five residence halls, opened two years later. In 1991, to celebrate the College's centenary anniversary, the College changed its name to Albertson College of Idaho, in honor of Kathryn and Joe Albertson, alumni and benefactors of the College. In October 2007, with the approval of the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation, the College returned to its original name.

Today, The College of Idaho continues to pioneer new ways to help students find a calling, in addition to a career. With the distinctive PEAK curriculum, students are enabled to graduate with an academic major and three minors in four years. The successful stories are many: Governors and elected officials. A Pulitzer Prize-winning historian. Founders of industry-leading companies. An Academy Award-winning composer. Eight Rhodes Scholars, three Marshall Scholars, and another 13 Truman and Goldwater Scholars.

The College of Idaho is an inclusive community of exceptional learning that challenges the ambitious and forges pathways to success and purpose.

ANSELME SADIKI



Anselme Sadiki joined the Children's Home Society of Idaho as its Executive Director in 2016. A native of Democratic Republic of Congo, formerly known as Zaïre, Sadiki was a student when the country's dictator launched a campaign of terror against students. Mr. Sadiki resettled in Pocatello as a political refugee, where he started over and completed his bachelor's degree in social work at Idaho State University. After graduation, he worked for ISU managing international student admission and the African student recruitment program. He earned a master's in International Affairs from Columbia University and went on to work for the United Nations Development Program (UNDP)

Mr. Sadiki managed the referendum project that resulted in the establishment of a new country – the Republic of South Sudan. He led development projects funded by the World Bank, the USAID, the African Development Bank, Japanese International Cooperation Agency, Norwegian International Development Fund in several countries in Africa and South-East Asia. After spending a dozen years with the UN, Mr. Sadiki returned to Idaho with his wife and daughter. Mr. Sadiki has used his professional experiences and skills to make a positive impact on the lives of Idahoans. A staunch advocate of children's wellbeing, Mr. Sadiki has worked tirelessly to build effective partnerships that focus on innovative solutions to address mental health issues for children and their families in our community. Together with Bobbi Hansberger, Anselme Sadiki has offered support and professional insights to our students in the department of Community Psychology here at The College of Idaho.

Mr. Sadiki currently sits on several committees and trustee boards, including, mission committee of the St. Alphonsus Health System, Riverstone International School Board, Neighbors United – A Refugee Advocacy Network Group. He received the Idaho State University Professional Achievement Award – College of Arts & Letters, Social & Behavioral Sciences – ISU 2023, Inspire Excellence Award – 2020, and the 48th Annual Frank Church Symposium award issued by International Affairs Council.

Causes Mr. Sadiki supports include Children, Human Rights and Social Action, Economic Empowerment, Education, Mental Health, Disaster and Humanitarian Relief, and Poverty Alleviation.

MIKE SHINES

Last fall we lost a beloved colleague, mentor, role model and friend, Mike Shines. Born and raised in the River Street District of Boise, Mike was blessed with wonderful parents, Joe and Burnell. They instilled in him strong values around community, justice, empathy, accountability, humor, listening, a legendary work ethic and a commitment to excellence. These values guided Mike throughout his life and he never forgot his roots. He made everyone feel welcomed and gave them a sense of belonging, becoming a wise counselor and mentor to thousands during his years of service at the Boise YMCA and for the past 32 years at The College of Idaho.

Known to many as Coach Shines, Mike wore many hats at The College of Idaho and he was always “all in” when taking on a role. His student-centric approach meant he always made time to accommodate students’ needs and schedules. Whether it was coming in on a Sunday with the football team, being there at 6 a.m. for a rehab appointment, meeting with a student at 9 p.m. in his role as life coach, replacing a pool pump during off hours to avoid pool closure, or working in the weight room, Mike could be found on campus at all hours of the day and every day of the week. No matter what he did, he always served as an important mentor for students. One could learn a lot about life just by watching Mike in action.

Mike was a pioneer at the College, taking on new roles and become the first ever: Swim Coach, Aquatic Director, Strength and Fitness Coach, Life Coach and Injury Rehab Specialist.

In addition to these roles, Mike took on many other duties simply because someone needed to do them. He detested sitting in meetings, but did so when he knew his voice was needed for those who did not have a seat at the table. He always listened more than he talked, but when he spoke it was with wisdom, humility and kindness.

The name Shines was very fitting, as his light always “shined” on others. One never left a meeting with Mike without feeling a little better, more hopeful and knowing that they mattered. His love for The College of Idaho and our students was unmatched. We pride ourselves in helping students find mentors and friends, and Mike was both to as many people from all walks of life as anyone we will ever meet. Mike had a PhD in life and it is fitting that we bestow this well-deserved honor in memory for one of the legendary figures in the history of The College of Idaho, Mike Shines.
